RESOLUTION NO. 45

A RESOLUTION DECLARING VALID AND CONSISTENT WITH LAW THE MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 8-2019 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MARIA AURORA, AURORA ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE PERTINENT PROVISIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT (DSWD) MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 04 S. 2019 ENTITLED OMNIBUS GUIDELINES IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SOCIAL PENSION FOR INDIGENT SENIOR CITIZENS AS REGARDS TO THE SOCIAL PENSION BEING PROVIDED BY THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF MARIA AURORA, AURORA"

WHEREAS, the SP Committee on Social Welfare, Women, and Family and the SP Committee on Laws, Ordinances, and Legal Matters to whom was referred the Municipal Ordinance No. 8-2019 of the Municipality of Maria Aurora, Aurora has considered the same in a committee hearing held for the purpose;

WHEREAS, the body affirmed and concurred with the following recommendations submitted by the abovementioned committees:

1. The title can be modified to emphasize the fact that the ordinance only aims to synchronize an already existing pension of the municipal government and it will not provide new additional stipends;
2. To further emphasize the previously mentioned statement, the second WHEREAS can be rephrased as "WHEREAS, the municipal government has existing pensions of which the scheduled release is quarterly;"
3. Section 3 can be modified to specify that the term "social pension" refers to that sponsored by the municipal government;
4. There are two Section 2 in the ordinance. The numbering of the sections must be adjusted accordingly, as well as the numbering of the items under Section 2B since there are no. 4 therein;

5. The effectivity clause of the ordinance can be modified to state that the ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after posting, in compliance to Section 59 of the Local Government Code.


NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Jennifer A. Araña, unanimously seconded,

BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to declare valid and consistent with law Municipal Ordinance No. 8-2019 of the Municipality of Maria Aurora, Aurora entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE PERTINENT PROVISIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT (DSWD) MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 04 S. 2019 ENTITLED OMNIBUS GUIDELINES IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SOCIAL PENSION FOR INDIGENT SENIOR CITIZENS AS REGARDS TO THE SOCIAL PENSION BEING PROVIDED BY THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF MARIA AURORA, AURORA."
