**RESOLUTION NO. 62**

**A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN OF AURORA'S POSITION TO THE CANCELLATION OF MAJOR ACTIVITIES IN THE CELEBRATION OF THE AURORA FOUNDATION DAY FOR THE YEAR 2020 IN ORDER TO PREVENT THE POSSIBLE SPREAD OF THE NOVEL CORONAVIRUS IN THE PROVINCE**

**WHEREAS**, with due regard to safe and healthy environment, as well as the global concern on the coronavirus (or CoViD19) outbreak, travel concerns, and other circumstances, Acting Governor Christian M. Noveras has cancelled the Celebration of the 41<sup>st</sup> Aurora Foundation Day which was to culminate on February 19, 2020;

**WHEREAS**, the global death toll due to the coronavirus is at least 1,357, while the global number of confirmed coronavirus cases has now exceeded 60,015, with the vast majority of cases in mainland China;

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Health issued an advisory on February 7, 2020, strongly urging the public to avoid attending and participating in events that draw a huge number of attendees, and recommending the cancellation of such events until further notice;

**WHEREAS**, the cancellation of major activities lined for the 41<sup>st</sup> Aurora Foundation Day celebration this month is a precautionary measure to prevent the transmission of the deadly virus to tourists and residents during mass gatherings in the province;

**WHEREAS**, in the event that a number of people are infected, our health facilities will not be capable of holding those who might show signs and symptoms related to the coronavirus disease or CoViD19:

**NOW THEREFORE**, on motion of Hon. JESUS V. PALMERO duly seconded,

**BE IT RESOLVED**, as it is hereby resolved, to convey our strong position to the cancellation of major activities in the celebration of the 41<sup>st</sup> Aurora Foundation Day for the year 2020 by the Honorable Christian M. Noveras, Acting Governor amidst the ongoing threat of the novel coronavirus to prevent its possible spread in the province.
