**RESOLUTION NO. 232**

**A RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY RECOMMENDING TO THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNOR THE CREATION OF A COMMITTEE WHICH WILL FOCUS ON THE STUDY AND EVALUATION OF OUR EXISTING WATERSHED AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF POTABLE WATER SYSTEM FOR SUPPLYING POTABLE WATER TO INHABITANTS OF MUNICIPALITIES IN THE PROVINCE OF AURORA**

**WHEREAS**, Aurora is fortunate to have plenty of rivers, streams, springs, falls and other sources of water, however, potable water supply is a prevalent problem in many of the communities throughout the province;

**WHEREAS**, majority of the municipalities in the province do not have water systems that provide regular and consistent supplies of potable water to every household therein;

**WHEREAS**, the existing Local Water District which has the mandate in the utilization and administration of local water sources and utilities cannot efficiently provide sufficient solution to this predicament;

**WHEREAS**, Local Government Units are mandated to provide basic services and facilities under Section 17 of the Local Government Code (LGC) which include inter-municipal waterworks systems;

**WHEREAS**, the same section of the LGC provides that the next higher level of local government unit may provide or augment the basic services and facilities assigned to a lower level of local government unit when such services or facilities are not made available or, if made available, are inadequate to meet the requirements of its inhabitants;

**NOW THEREFORE**, on motion of Hon. Mariano C. Tangson, duly seconded,

**BE IT RESOLVED**, as it is hereby resolved, to respectfully recommend to the Provincial Governor, Hon. Gerardo A. Noveras creation of a committee which will focus on the study and evaluation of our existing watershed and the establishment of potable water system for supplying potable water to inhabitants of municipalities in the Province of Aurora.
