### PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 338

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 AND 4 OF PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 168, SERIES OF 2008, "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE TRADING, SELLING AND BUYING OF COCONUT PRODUCTS, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES"**

**WHEREAS**, the practice of obliging coconut farmers to give away twenty (20) pieces of young coconut fruit for every one hundred pieces is inequitable and unjust to the coconut farmers who are unwilling victims to this scheme;

**WHEREAS**, the municipality of San Luis has an ordinance which provides for only ten (10) pieces of palyo and to be identical and consistent with the same it is proper to reduce the number of palyo allowed in the above entitled ordinance;

**NOW THEREFORE**, on motion of Hon. Lordan B. Roxas, unanimously seconded;

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN in session duly assembled;

**SECTION 1.** Section 1 of Provincial Ordinance No. 168, Series of 2008 is hereby amended to read as follows:

*Section 1. Short Title. This ordinance shall be known as "The Coconut Trading Ordinance of Aurora".*

**SECTION 2.** Section 4, paragraph 2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

*Section 4. Regulatory Provisions. – The following are the regulated acts:*

*2. There shall be straight counting of young coconut fruit (buko or mura) with only **ten (10) pieces** of "palyo" per one hundred (100) pieces of nuts.*

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall be effective after compliance with the requirements of posting as provided in Section 59 of the Local Government Code.


