Prospective bidders should possess a valid PCAB License applicable to the contract, have completed a similar contract with a value of at least 50% of the ABC, and have key personnel and equipment available for the prosecution of the contract. The BAC will use non-discretionary pass/fail criteria in the Eligibility Check/Screening as well as the Preliminary Examination of Bids. The BAC will conduct post-qualification of the lowest calculated bid.

All particulars relative to Eligibility Statement and Screening, Bid Security, Performance Security, Pre-bidding Conference, Evaluation of Bids, Post Qualification and Award of Contract shall be governed by the pertinent provisions of RA 9184 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR). The schedule of BAC activities is as follows:

The BAC will issue to prospective bidders Eligibility Forms at BAC Secretariat Office, Capitol Compound, Baler, Aurora, upon their submission of a LOI. Prospective bidders shall submit the Eligibility Requirements to the BAC at the said address. They may also obtain the results of the Eligibility Check by the BAC at the same address. Bids document will be available only to prospective bidders upon payment to the Provincial Treasurer’s Office (PTO) of the Provincial Government of Aurora (PGA) of non-refundable amount for the following approved budget for the contract:
